At the Paris location, the receptionist helped us pick out products for us.

Located in a courtyard on Champs-Élysées, the spa is easy to miss if you're not looking for it.

What did I get? EVERYTHING. My entire skincare routine is now made up of their products. I LOVE it. My skin has never looked better and I wear a lot less makeup.

I start off with their Lait VIP O2 cleansing milk, followed by their famous P50W (a liquid exfoliant), a serum, and a facial cream. I got two facial creams; one for morning, and for night. Twice a week, I do their Masque Vivant facial mask, which is AMAZING. But holy crap, the stuff smells horrible! In fact, a lot of their products smell awful. Really awful. No masking their products with pretty scents here.
