Service & facilities

Special touches, such as the private cinema, kids' club or live music at weekends, set the Majestic apart. The cinema, complete with sofas and velvet wingback armchairs, offers a Sunday Champagne Cinema Club from the autumn. In summer, La Plage beach club comes into its own, with the largest jetty on the Croisette. After sunset, the mood shifts from water-sports and beach games to partying at the buzzing bar, or a dinner beach cabaret followed by clubbing.

Service is that rare combination of smooth but personal, with staff you simply want to take home with you, both in the bars and the spa. The Diane Barrière Spa is not the sexiest but the best in Cannes, both for marine facials and bespoke massages. Newly revamped, the spa offers both the botanical and marine know-how of Biologique Recherche and the exoticism of Ligne St Barth, with passion-fruit massages.

Rooms

The Majestic's palette of ivory and beige extends to the plush coffee-and-cream bedrooms, with Nespresso coffee on tap, and matching, mosaic-studded bathrooms. Splash out on a sea view to take in the island-spangled bay and Esterel mountains. Even if the standard rooms are swish enough, the slew of celebrity suites keeps the movie crowd coming back.

The Christian Dior Suite, with its dove-grey panelling and parquet floor, was inspired by Dior's Parisian home. This fashionista penthouse becomes the stars' dressing room during the Film Festival. Yet the real star is the sumptuously domed Majestic Suite, with a home cinema, lantern-hung deck and dreamlike views of the Lérins Islands from the private pool.
