Futuristic Facial

We recently stopped into Paul Labrecque Salons & Spa for our very first laser treatment, care of the lovely Carmen Tresado. Labrecque's resident laser specialist, Tresado's new 3D Facial (\$1,000 for 30 minutes) begins with a cleanse using **Bioderma**. Tresado then uses the **Laser Pico** and concludes with a diamond-tipped microdermabrasion mask. Next up was the **Laser Gommé**, which felt like a scrub and brightened a few dark spots that its typical counterparts had yet to clear up.

Tresado gave fair warning before applying the "slightly hot gotta" collagen plumping **Laser Titan** and kindly noted that she could reduce the intensity at any point. To our surprise, apart from a pinch here and there, the Titan was virtually painless.
